BARCELONA THIS YEAR, OFF TO AUSTRALIA NEXT YEAR!

They were among 16-20,000 Rotarians from 209 Countries represented at the 93rd Annual Rotary International Convention. Their trip was June 23-26 and a binder proving they were there was shared.

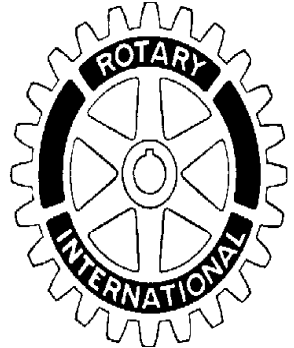
Opening session and closing sessions were first class. Jerry Lewis, closing ceremony speaker, received \$100,000 from Rotary International as recipient of the Humanitarian Award. Mr. Lewis was very touched by this award and said he would mention the great work of Rotary during his telethon.

District Award went to Past District Director Tully. Ken Berry spoke on his wheelchair campaign, whereas he matches \$75 for every \$75 donation. So far 15,000 chairs have been distributed.

Steve Tate was pinned by Arlene in anticipation of the Rotary International Conference next year to be held in Brisbane, Australia on June 1-4, 2003. **Ahoy Mate!**

 The Rotary special interest license plate is an official license plate
 Issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles for vehicles registered in California.
 Proceeds from the sale of these plates will benefit educational and community
 Outreach activities supported by Rotary International. The plate contains the
 Words "Service Above Self" and the emblem of the Rotary International.

So far there are 867 applications on file and 7,500 are needed by December 31, 2002. If all applications are returned, it would mean \$300,00 back to the clubs annually.
