JAMES BOYS RANCH

Steve Tate discussed the need for a library at the ranch. All they have is used paperbacks that aren't pertinent to their training or level of reading.

Kirsten Estelle, counselor at the ranch, stated that the Boys Ranch is a minimum security facility with 96 minors from the ages of 16-19 years. The focus is on rehabilitation. Vocational training — auto mechanic, horticulture and welding skills. Budget cutbacks have forced them to drop the G.E.D. program.

120 day stay maximum, Russ Danielson (MH Rotary), Bob Sigala, Kristen Estelle and Rey Mendizabel formed a group to try to generate funds for the ranch called Upward Bound Youth.

Kirsten brought two boys with her, Juan Anderson, 18 years old and Armando Perales. 2 participants have passed with certification in cabling classes.

Bob Sigala stated that the Boy's Ranch original program was agriculturally based for over 30 years. The minors do need their G.E.D. in order to succeed.
