This is based on all the input provided to Steve Tate on how to improve the tournament. He states to please remember we did a whole lot of things right and had a very successful tournament! There will be a meeting following the 10/30 meeting to discuss how to follow-up on these suggestions.

Lessons Learned – 2002 Rotary Golf Tournament

- More beer on the course.
- Need co-chairs for volunteers, awareness of outside volunteer sources.
- Reporting structure needs to be really clear,
- Routing of entries, sponsorships, bills, etc. needs to be documented and followed by all.
- Need documentation – task descriptions for all areas.
- Get a complete mailing list of participants, go to members to get unknowns.
- Live auction should be 10 items max, started during dinner, before any awards or raffle.
- Need some play-acting during live auction on getting min. bids, etc., should be set up and rehearsed.
- More club participants at the course, be there or get a sub. We were short.
- Time to redesign brochure, don't put a limit on number and allow more categories like sleeve and putting green.
- Maintain respect for all those working on the event, we're all volunteers.
- Separate the raffle items from the silent auction items, have raffle items at registration and on the course to encourage sales, etc.
- Need to develop a list of potential outside sponsors and go after them.
- Consider doing a 30 second TV promo slot to get more players – other ideas to fill tournament.
- Have greeters, possibly older Rotarians.
- Redesign the auction form for usability.
- Better expense control, set up guidelines on how many to buy for, approve all expenditures.
- Short sleeve t-shirts, can still do sleeve sponsors (long sleeve over twice price).
- Better coordination among committee members (missing sponsor sign, etc.)
- Improve Club membership support. (penalize non-participants?)
- "Script" or outline of the program before/during/after dinner and rehearsal.
- Document the procedure for the auction.
- Develop a procurement strategy for the auction.
- Have a hard cut-off date/time for receiving auction items.
- Better coverage of other Rotary Clubs to get participation – multiple mailings, etc.
- Deadline for payment of moneys owed with penalty for nonconformance.
