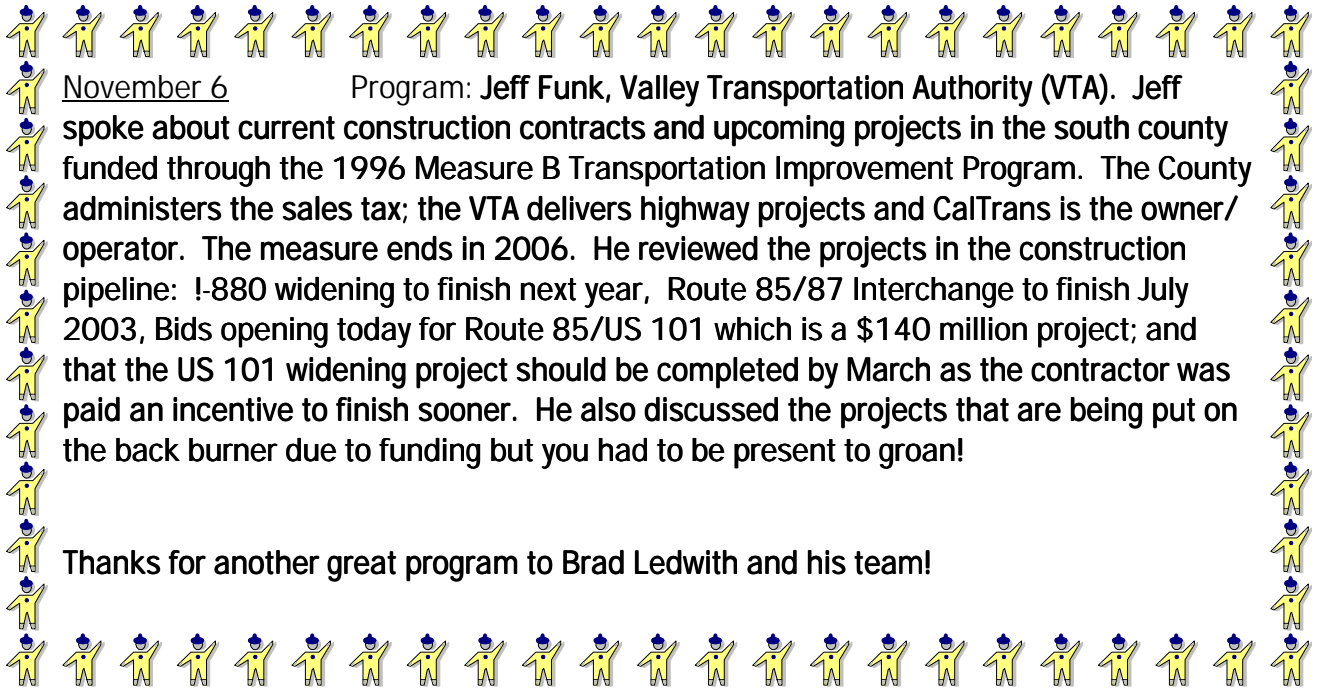
Steve Tate said it was the vote for two, only two that kept the voters with him!

November 6 Program: **Jeff Funk, Valley Transportation Authority (VTA)**. Jeff spoke about current construction contracts and upcoming projects in the south county funded through the 1996 Measure B Transportation Improvement Program. The County administers the sales tax; the VTA delivers highway projects and CalTrans is the owner/operator. The measure ends in 2006. He reviewed the projects in the construction pipeline: I-880 widening to finish next year, Route 85/87 Interchange to finish July 2003, Bids opening today for Route 85/US 101 which is a \$140 million project; and that the US 101 widening project should be completed by March as the contractor was paid an incentive to finish sooner. He also discussed the projects that are being put on the back burner due to funding but you had to be present to groan!
