**VETERAN'S DAY OBSERVANCE
A Day to Remember**

Ira B. Marshall, Program Chair for the Veteran's Day Agenda, provided a salute to Club Veterans and Guests. Ira gave an overview of the Morgan Hill Rotary Veteran's Day Program and introduced the special speaker for the day.

The presentation was given by Edward F. (Ted) Cadwallader on "My Experience as a POW during WWII... a civilian perspective. He was a civilian internee's, Santo Tomas Internment Camp, Manila, Philippines, 1942-1945. He was three years old when the Imperial Japanese Navy attacked Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941. Shortly after the attack, the 14th Southern Area Army, Imperial Japanese Army invaded the Philippine Islands and enemy aliens, including Ted and his family, were lorded to report with two suitcases to the University of Santo Tomas compound, which soon became known as the Santo Tomas Internment Camp. Ted and his family spent 37 months in camp as prisoners.

They were liberated under fire by the U.S. 1st Cavalry Division and "B" Company of the 44th Tank Battalion on February 3, 1945. There were 3,700 internees in the camp at that time.

Mr. Cadwallader shared his personal experiences as a young boy in a Japanese prison camp.
