Rotary Re: Web Site Update

The website is <http://www.morganhillrotary.com>

>>> The "Members Only" section of the Rotary Club website is now up and running thanks to a lot of hard work by **John Tarvin** and **David Lister**. Please take a look. The "Members Only" section is protected by encrypted passwords and contains information for Club members only that will be kept confidential from others. For starters, the Club Roster is on this page. Now you don't have to remember where you lost the printed roster when you want to e-mail someone. You can just look up the member's name and click on their e-mail address to invoke your e-mail program and generate the message. You can also change your password and e-mail of record. As time goes on, more useful Club information will be available in this section. When you go to the "Members Only" page, you will be asked for a User ID and a Password.

So, how do I log on if I don't know what they are? Well, here's the trick. The first time you use the members only page, you will need to go through a simple four step process to get your password.

First step: click on the button that says "forgot my password." This will send you to a screen to get a new password.

Second Step: On this screen enter your User ID. Your User ID is your first initial and your last name, ie: sSteve Schwab is sSchwab. Then press the button to get your password.

Third Step: Go to your e-mail program. Within seconds you will receive an e-mail with a computer generated temporary password. This password will be made up of numbers and capital and small case letters. This is your temporary password. Write it down.

Fourth Step: Go back to the "Members Only" page web site and enter your User ID and computer generated temporary password. Wala! your in!

Remember that the passwords are case sensitive. Since these temporary passwords make no sense, you will probably want to change your password to something that makes sense to you and something you can remember. You can do that from the menu once you are in the members only section. No one will have anyway of knowing or changing your password except you. These are computer generated and encrypted, untouched by human brains. If you have any problems, you can e-mail me (**Steve Schwab**) through the web site, or e-mail **John Tarvin** directly. Either way, we will get you up and running.

Subject: ROTARY LICENSE PLATES

Please forward this to all club members.

The Rotary clubs in California did not get the required 7500 applications turned in by December 31, 2002, the deadline date that was written in our RLP Bill AB1129. What happens now? Since our 2633 already submitted RLP applications have brought in a total of \$221,925, Rotary International Director Elect, Ron Beaubien, felt this was a project Rotary should not abandon. District Governor Jim Parsons from D5320 will be our new Multi-District RLP leader starting July 1, 2003, to lead us in the successful completion of this Task Force project.

Frequently Asked Questions:

1) What happened to my check that I submitted months ago?

All RLP checks were deposited into our Rotary License Plate account which had been established at the Cupertino National Bank in Cupertino, CA so that these checks would not become stale-dated.

2) What about my Credit Card payment?

NO credit card payments were processed. Those applications with credit card payments will not be processed until we have our total 7500 applications turned in and ready to submit to the state.

3) When will this Task Force RLP project start?

Even though our RLP project is already in effect, and we are still accepting and posting each application as it is submitted, our RLP Task Force project will actually start July 1, 2003.

4) When will this project end?

Because our RLP project has changed from a STATE project governed by what was written in our bill to now a ROTARY Task Force Project, the end will come as soon as we reach our 7500 submission requirement.

5) So we have no ending date?

Even though our ending date is now open, it is our Rotary International Director Elect, Ron Beaubien and District Governor Jim Parson's goal to get our total 7500 RLP applications turned in within the next 12-24 months.

The faster our clubs submit their applications, the sooner we will get our Rotary License Plates made. If you have previously paid for your RLP application, and you do not wish to continue in our efforts to successfully complete this project, please contact us at Rlicenseplates@aol.com for us to refund your check. Remember, the constant everyday exposure these license plates will bring to Rotary is invaluable. Plus, this is an automatic fundraiser for every club that participates. Here's a simple table to show you how much your club receives and when:
