Proceed east on Dunne Avenue and begin your ascent into the foothills of the Diablo Mountains. Once you have crossed the first ridge (you begin to descend for the first time since climbing) you will take the first right turn onto Jackson Oaks Drive. Begin climbing yet again. The second street to the left is Oak Hill Court. Proceed down Oak Hill Court until it dead-ends. The clubhouse is at the very end of the street. Parking is available below Oak Hill Court near the clubhouse or on the street.

During dusk hours the deer come out to feed on our landscaping. Please drive carefully and watch out for the local fauna. If you happen to get lost, please call David Lister (408-309-9845) and we will send out a search and rescue party.
