Last Weeks Programs

PROGRAM:

Sherry Hemmingway introduced this weeks speaker, Mike Langberg, the Technology columnist for the Mercury News..

Mike is the Mercury News person who 'Test' drives products that are new in technology and writes a general technology column to inform us less technology people. Mike focused on letting us focus on the perspective of the bigger picture relative to technology products. First, Futurist always over estimate. In January 1983, the personal computer was said to plug into the phone line and this would be as common as TV's. About 1993, the home computer became common place in homes. Some quotes that Mike said were technology related are:

- Online advertising in 2003 exceeded all expectations.
